## Consent for taking the children to Church and on the Village walkways

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) May 2018 explains that:

• Consent must be a freely given, specific, informed and an unambiguous indication of your wishes. There must be a clear affirmative action showing your consent. Also, consent can be removed, however there may be another legal basis for processing your personal data.

Over the course of the school academic year we take the children to church on the following occasions: -

- For whole school assemblies at least once, each half term
- To practice the Christmas Carol Service, Nativity
- To practice for the Year 6 Leavers Assembly.
- To enrich the curriculum e.g. when studying local history

Over the course of the year, we may use the local pathways and woodland areas to enrich the curriculum on occasions. For example: - when we are studying Geography or teaching the children orienteering.

Lancashire legal department has informed us that they highly recommend school get written consent from parents to do this.

The following consent will last for the whole time that your child is at Singleton School unless you advise us otherwise.
